DEVELOPMENTS IN ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK AND SERVICES

Rakuten targets Satellite-to-Mobile Service Launch in 2026

The Japanese operator intends to plug into AST SpaceMobile's space-based cellular broadband network, which is accessed directly by smartphones, and provide text messaging, voice and data services, with a target date of 2026. **Telecoms.com** (read more)
