In 2017, for the first time in the history of the Belgian postal market, the parcels and express shipments segment has become the most important in terms of revenues. Parcels and express shipments have more than offset the contraction in press and letter post segments so that the Belgian postal market expanded by 4.3% to reach a total turnover of €2.6bn in 2017 [read more – subscription required].
