# Ofcom to put more 5G spectrum up for auction in 2019

Ofcom has said that it plans to put more spectrum up for auction in the second half of 2019, as the UK looks to ramp up its preparations for 5G. Ofcom plans to put two distinct blocks of spectrum up for auction, in the 700MHz and 3.6-3.8GHz bands [read more – subscription required].

## Finnish government renews 900 MHz, 1800 MHz and 2 GHz mobile licences

Following a beauty contest, the Finnish government awarded nine mobile licences. The licences include all of the harmonised spectrum in 900 MHz, 1800 MHz and (paired) 2 GHz bands to the three established mobile network operators (MNOs) DNA, Elisa and Telia Finland [read more – subscription required].
